Dr. Engela Honey qualified as a paediatrician in 1994 at the University of Stellenbosch, Cape Town South Africa. After 4 years as a paediatrician Engela took up a post at the University of Pretoria, Department of Genetics, Division of Human Genetics, Pretoria, South Africa where she trained in Clinical Genetics. She has subsequently become involved in the care of children with birth defects and genetic disorders as well as host genetic clinics at all the hospitals affiliated to the University of Pretoria. She also does outreach clinics to Witbank and Dr. George Mukhari hospital and consults with patients in the private sector referred by paediatricians in and around Pretoria.

Engela is a member of the South African Society for Human Genetics and served on the committee on two occasions, 1999-2004 and again 2013-2015. She is also the medical advisor of the Prader-Willi Syndrome Association and a member of other support groups. She has a keen interest in rare diagnosis and help with the workup of some of the cases, and offers genetic counselling and help with prenatal diagnosis. She has authored 16 articles of which most have dealt with rare diseases. She loves classical music, the nature and reading.
