Dr Burger is a Specialist Clinical Oncologist and Senior lecturer in the Division of Radiation Oncology, Stellenbosch University (SUN) and Tygerberg Academic Hospital in Cape Town, South Africa. She obtained her undergraduate medical degree from SUN in 2001. Her interest in Oncology started while working in the UK as a medical officer in the fields of Oncology, Haematology and Palliative care. She returned to Cape Town in 2005 to join the Haematology service at Groote Schuur Hospital (GSH).
