



## **Gareth Baynam**

Gareth is a Clinical Geneticist at Genetic Services of Western Australia; an Adjunct Policy Advisor on Clinical Genomics at the WA Department of Health; Director of the Undiagnosed Diseases Program – Western Australia, and Head of the Western Australian Register of Developmental Anomalies. He is a Clinical Associate Professor at the School of Paediatrics and Child Health - University of Western Australia, the Institute for Immunology and Infectious Diseases - Murdoch University and at Spatial Sciences - Curtin University. He is an Honorary research fellow at Telethon Kids Institute. His PhD was in genetic modifiers of vaccine response in children and he leads a 3D facial analysis research team. He is co-chair of the Diagnostics Scientific Committee of the International Rare Diseases Research Consortium. He is a member of the Orphanet Australia National Advisory Body and of the Rare Voices Australia Scientific and Medical Advisory Committee. He holds a Raine Clinician Research Fellowship: 1 in 12: Translational Research for Rare Diseases. He is a Founding Member of the Board of Directors of the Undiagnosed Diseases Network – International.
